On behalf of Austin Academy faculty and staff, we sincerely appreciate the parental support and involvement in our implementation of the House system and AVID binders. As we are still in the beginning phases of utilizing our Houses, it has efficaciously served to connect all students to the campus and enhance the sense of community (wearing house shirts, panoramic photos on house day and attending school events), promoted student organization (use of binders/planners) and supported community service (box tops and canned food drives). At this point in the semester, each of the three houses have been recognized for attaining high house points. In the first cycle, House Integrity earned the most points for binders, planners and house shirts. House Empower was recognized for earning the greatest number of box tops for Austin.
