### A Word From Our PTA President - Marylee Lajoie - mlajoie4@tx.rr.com

As I sit here and listen to the birds singing and see the sun shining, I cannot believe how quickly time passes and that we are only a couple months away from summer break. This year has been a whirlwind of new things for our kids, from the Avid Binder system that was successfully rolled out but still gets some grumblings, to the fantastic House Carnival that the teachers put together for the school.

Even though wonderful things have happened this year, I want to pause for a moment and reflect on the tragedy that struck some of our students on December 26<sup>th</sup>. I'm sure everyone can remember where they were when the tornado hit our community. My family was frantically running around the house trying to figure out the best bathtub to sit in! Unfortunately, several families in our Austin community were impacted directly and I was reminded today, as I sat in church on Palm Sunday, that their struggle is not over.

To refresh your memories:

- -There were about 9 families that were impacted by the tornados from December 26<sup>th</sup> that have children at Austin. Some of those families were displaced from their homes.
- -Garland ISD provided backpacks and school supplies to these students.

At the time, our Eagle community generously came through with donations for these families. The PTA sent home an AAE pack with these students that included Austin spirit gear, a sweatshirt, a cup and house shirts. Families from our school donated gift cards to Wal-Mart and other grocery stores to help these families get fed. One family alone, generously donated nine \$50 gift cards on their own! What a joy to see the love and caring in our own Austin Eagle family.

Now that it's three months later, I would like to ask for your help once again. In any crisis, it is standard that the community rallies immediately in response to help. Unfortunately, sometimes, the real struggle comes much later, when the donations have dried up, and you find your family still living temporary housing and trying to make ends meet. I am asking for our Austin Community to step up once again and see if we can help those victims of the Rowlett Tornado.

The AAE PTA will be doing a gift card drive during the month of April. We are requesting that families donate gift cards of any denomination, from any store to these families. You may purchase new gift cards, or if you are like my family, you may have some gift cards still in your wallet from Christmas that were never used.
